

Chrome & Safari Autocomplete Setting 2014.11.11

If you are using the browsers **Google-Chrome** or **Safari**, please note...

The problem:

Due to a recent default "Setting" of these Browsers, when you add a "**Self-enrolment (Student) Method**" in the "moodle@NovaSBE" Platform, they add (automatically) the User's "**Username**" as the "**Instance name**" and the User's "**Password**" as the "**Enrollment Key**".

The solutions:

- ➔ These Browsers "**Autocomplete Setting**" should be disabled – here's how:
<https://yoast.com/autocomplete-security/>
or
use the Recommended Browser "**Firefox**", instead.
- ➔ **In Chrome** there is yet another way – by using the "**browse in private**" (which allows the configuration of the "Self-enrolment Method" without disabling that Setting above)
2 ways of doing it:

Method 1.

In the Chrome window where you want to open "moodle@NovaSBE"

- go to the **Browser Settings** – upper right corner, under the "X" – and
- click on "**New incognito window**".

The other (open) windows will not be affected.



Method 2.


Right-click the mouse when clicking the “Enrolment Methods”:

- click “Open link in Incognito window”, and
- you’ll be asked for a new “Login”:



In both cases

In the upper left corner you’ll see:



So far, this is relevant only when setting the “**Self-enrolment method**”.

How to undo these Settings:

These Settings will be restored when you close that window; other windows will be in “normal” mode..
