Chrome & Safari Autocomplete Setting 2014.11.11

If you are using the browsers Google-Chrome or Safari, please note...

The problem:

Due to a recent default "Setting" of these Browsers, when you add a "**Self-enrolment (Student) Method**" in the "moodle@NovaSBE" Platform, they add (automatically) the User's "<u>Username</u>" as the "Instance name" and the User's "<u>Password</u>" as the "Enrollment Key".

The solutions:

These Browsers "Autocomplete Setting" should be disabled – here's how: https://yoast.com/autocomplete-security/ or

use the Recommended Browser "Firefox", instead.

 In Chrome there is yet another way – by using the "browse in private" (which allows the configuration of the "Self-enrolment Method" without disabling that Setting above)
 2 ways of doing it:

Method 1.

In the Chrome window where you want to open "moodle@NovaSBE"

- go to the Browser Settings upper right corner, under the "X" and
 click on "New incognito window".
- The other (open) windows will not be affected.
