"M-Learning" **is more than being "always online**"; it is for on-the-go learning, "**anytime, anywhere**" even when disconnected since it can be done through the delivery of offline contents, previously downloaded.

NOTE: the moodle APP can't do everything. This APP allows you to access most content but some can't be viewed with it; in that case, a message will be displayed telling you to use the Web-Browser version instead.



How to setup "moodle (Mobile) APP"

1. click the link in the Footer



OR

in the User's **Profile** page (under the User's name)

This message shows that the Site has "moodle APP" enabled but the logged User didn't use it yet.

2. How to get the "mobile APP":



It is available for free from Google Play and the Apple Store for download and install:

- search for the mobile APP "<u>Moodle Pty Ltd</u>", then
- type the complete address (URL) of the School's moodle Site https://moodle.novasbe.pt/
- tap "CONNECT" and enter your credentials...

3. This message in the User's **Profile** Mobile app connected means this APP is ready to be used.

NOTE - to create another User connection in the APP:

- tap the "

- enter the Site (full) address (https://moodle.novasbe.pt/), and tap "CONNECT!",

• via APP:

- 1. go to the "APP Settings" then "Notification preferences" (or Message preferences) (Fig 8),
- 2. move the slider so that "disable Notifications" is off,
- 3. move the slider to turn on Notifications for Assignment, Feedback, Forum etc. as required

OR

via <u>Website</u>:

- 1. go to your "User Menu" (top right of each page) and select "Preferences",
- 2. click "Notification preferences" (or Message preferences)
- 3. click to turn on Notifications for Assignment, Feedback, Forum etc. as required.
