# Approximate expenses per month in Euro

- Our Campus Dormitory : Between 250-300 Euros (http://www.resu.ma/residences/ziraoui/) (Single/Double room)
- Apartments : shared flat between 500-750 Euros (for an apartment including electricity and water) - 10 min walking distance
- Food: 250-350 Euro
- Public transportation : 50-100 Euros/ Tramway 8 MAD one way/ Monthly card 230 MAD

If your country is not on this list, then you should apply for a visa from the Moroccan consulate in your country and present these documents:

- Application form duly filled
- Valid passport
- 3 identity photos
- Acceptance letter delivered by ESCA Ecole de Management

The period of stay the Morocco for foreigners exempted from visa is limited to 3 months. You must request an authorization from the

General Office of National Security with the same documents as above in addition to:

- The rental agreement which must be in your name.
- A copy of the entry stamp in Moroccan territory

If the incoming student leaves the territory of Morocco during the 3 months and comes back, his stay will be systematically extended for the other 3 months.



International Insurance is Mandatory for all exchange students.
