Overview	<i>Renmin Business School</i> boasts the longest history of management education in China, dating back to 1950. The school has close to 4,000 students and over 150 faculty members. It has obtained both EQUIS and AACSB accreditations, and is placed the 39 th and the 13 th respectively in the most recent FT rankings of MBA and Executive Education programs.

Requirements	● Fluent English ● A minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale), or average score of 80 (out of 100) or 56 (out of 70). ● Chinese passport holders are not accepted.		
Course Offering	● We have two programs in English--BBA (Bachelor of Business Administration) and IMBA (international MBA). Each offers around 15 courses in English each semester. ● Incoming exchange students can take no more than 5 courses each semester. ● We don't offer Chinese language course.		
Credit Transfer	● Our courses are 2 or 3 credits each (2 or 3 weekly class hours respectively). Normally, courses lasts 17 weeks, and exams are scheduled for the 18th or 19th week. ● In general, 1 Renmin credit is considered equivalent to 2 ECTS credits, subject to the home university's calculation.		
Special Services	● Buddy program: one-on-one assistance throughout the semester. ● Student activities: campus tour, Christmas party, travels to scenic spots.
