NUCB Scholarship	<p>NUCB offers scholarship to exchange students with outstanding academic record. Upon nomination from Partner School, successful recipients are placed into either of the following categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NUCB(I) <u>Scholarship: 35,000 yen/month</u> for the monthly rent at NUCB Global Center. Residence. Utility fees are not included in the coverage. <u>Eligibility: Attendance above 95.00% and GPA above 3.00</u> (by NUCB scale) <u>in the most recent term / (semester for DDP students) completed.</u> • NUCB(II) <u>Scholarship: 25,000 yen/month</u> for the monthly rent at NUCB Residence. Utility fees are not included in the coverage. <u>Eligibility: Attendance above 95.00% and GPA above 2.20</u> (by NUCB scale) <u>in the most recent term / (semester for DDP students) completed.</u>
JASSO Scholarship	<p>Japan Student Service Organization (JASSO) Scholarship is available if NUCB is allocated certain slots by JASSO. In 2016, the scholarship was 48,000 yen per month for each student. *Selection is very competitive. *Only for semester-long exchange students, “JASSO Short-Program Scholarship” might be offered during their study in Japan. Details are announced via email.</p> <p><u>Eligibility: GPA 2.30 (by JASSO scale)</u> In case there are more eligible students than allocated slots, recipients are selected from top in accordance with their GPA.</p> <p>Please note that JASSO scholarship, under Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology - Japan (MEXT), depends on Government funding.
