The course offer in the different campuses differs, so it might be worthwhile checking this varied course offer. To give you an idea:

Campus **Antwerp** has some interesting Business courses with a focus on the Harbor logistics (but of course there also other courses)

Campus **Brussels** has a strong focus on Business and Management (both Bachelor and Master entirely in English with additional minors)

For **Brussels & Antwerp**, the courses have a more hands-on approach, with slightly less focus on quantitative skills but more on business and management.

Campus **Leuven** has a smaller offer on the Bachelor level but it has a large offer for the Master with many interesting courses in Economics. FEB courses in fields such as economics and finance tend to be very analytical. Bachelor students should be well versed in mathematics/statistics.

Students will be able to find some finance courses within our offer but it is up to the student to check whether the content of the courses matches what they need.
