Courses within application

- A wide range of courses coming from different programmes
- Choose the correct campus where courses reflect your current background
- Make sure you have the requested background for each course
- Full-time workload at KU Leuven: 30 ECTS credits/semester (5 courses)
- Send the choice of courses in your application (learning agreement LA)
- Deadline application 1 October (starting in February) or 1 May (starting in September)
















Buddy system


- Personal buddy, a KU Leuven student (Flemish or another international student) who will answer all your practical questions.
