This e-mail is a short update on the rules for entering Denmark.

No red countries or regions

In case you have not heard, the country categories were updated on Friday and there are now **no red countries or regions**. In general, countries/regions that were previously red are now considered orange.

Since the requirements may have changed for some of you, please remember to check the Danish authorities' website:

Confirmation of worthy purpose

Some students resident in orange countries will still need a confirmation of worthy purpose to enter Denmark (see the above link to check). If this applies to you, please remember to print out and have your confirmation of enrolment with you when you enter Denmark. (Your confirmation of enrolment was sent to your KUmail last week.)

Check the requirements before you travel

Please remember that the information in this e-mail is not a replacement for reading the <u>Danish</u> <u>authorities' website</u>. The rules for entry can and do change, so we advise all students to visit the <u>Danish</u> <u>authorities' website</u> and contact their Arrivals Hotline (+45 7020 6044) before travelling.
