Transcript of Records	These are issued by the International Office soon after the student has completed their Erasmus or Exchange period. Only exams passed are included on the Transcripts of Records. <b>Information is not given about failed exams.</b>
Academic grading system	The Italian grading system works on a scale from 18 to 30. 18 is the lowest pass grade and 30 the highest. In case of a particularly exceptional performance, "lode" can be assigned and the grade is registered as 30 cum laude.
Credit system CFU ECTS	1 CFU or ECTS corresponds to 25 hours teaching/study time.
Tuition Fees (for Erasmus and Exchange Students)	Tuition fees are waived only for students from partner universities who have signed a cooperation agreement with the University of Milano-Bicocca.
