Program Structure

To pass Mastering Your Career you need to complete **five mandatory sections**: Discovery Week, CV Checkpoint, Career Workshop, Career Events, and Career Fair. **You will need to fulfill the requirements within each section** to pass the course and receive the 2 ECTS. None of these sections is worth any ECTS on its own.

Aside from this mandatory component, the Careers @ Nova SBE team has also outlined some activities and resources that we strongly recommend you to make the most of: you can book a counseling session with one of the Career Consultants available, join Business Challenges, register for the Career Mentoring Program, participate at the Spring Career Fair and attend other career workshops and career events that might interest you.

1. Mandatory Sections

Discovery Week	Aug. 30 th to Sep. 1 st	Welcome week to all Master students, with career-related events.	Mandatory to attend the whole DW event.	All students are automatically enrolled.
Virtual Career Fair	Sep 22 nd	Involving more than 40 organizations, the main goal is to promote closer interaction between Employers and all students from Nova SBE.	Mandatory for students to attend at least 1 Talk during the Career Fair.	Students have to attend this activity by registering in Vfairs. Attendance will be provided by the Vfairs platform.
Career Workshops	Sep-Nov	Workshops organized and held by the Careers @ Nova SBE, with internal and external facilitators/speakers, with career-related topics.	Mandatory to attend 1 Career Workshop in the Fall semester of their Masters.	Students have to choose the Career Workshop that is most attractive to them and enroll through the bidding system.
Career Events	Sep-Nov	Career events, aiming to help students complement and consolidate relevant information and tools to increase the knowledge of the market and the success rate of recruitment processes.	Mandatory to attend a minimum of 2 Career Events during the Fall semester.	Students must enroll in the Career Events powered by MYC, by registering in Job Teaser, Nova SBE Career Center. In each event, we will inform the students how the attendance will be controlled.
CV Checkpoint (VMOCK)	Until Nov. 26 th	A platform to help you build a powerful CV, according to Nova SBE guidelines.	Students must upload their CV on VMOCK until November 26 and get a minimum of 70 points .	All students are automatically registered on this platform.

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2. Career Online Tools

Nova SBE students have exclusive access to several online tools where they can find valuable information for their job hunt:

- Nova SBE Career Center by JobTeaser the students' door to the marketplace! Companies have direct access to Nova SBE Career Center by Job Teaser and to students' CVs (if approved by the student). Among other services, it includes a *Resources* database with extensive support materials.
- *HigherEd* a job search platform by EFMD, a Network to which Nova SBE belongs. You can access it via Nova SBE Career Center.
- *GoinGlobal* worldwide job/internship listings and international career guides. Goinglobal is accessible via Nova SBE Career Center quick links on the home page.
- *Vault* job search help with career advice and mock interviews, among others, organized by sector. Vault is accessible via Nova SBE Career Center quick links on the home page.
- *VMock* an online tool that provides detailed feedback to improve your CV down to the last bullet point. Students receive access to VMock via e-mail.
- *Big Interview* It's a step-by-step system that combines experts video lessons and an interactive video practice tool to help students land their dream jobs.
- *Graduates First* Practice free online numerical, verbal, logical reasoning, personality tests, assessment center exercises.
- *Preplounge* Prepare for case interviews and launch your career in consulting. Have access to unlimited mock interviews with peers from all over the world and extensive content unlocked.

Access to Nova SBE Career Tools is covered by Nova SBE Code of Conduct. Access is exclusive to Nova SBE students who are responsible for the reliability and veracity of their profile information. Noncompliance with these rules implies the application of sanctions accordingly, including the exclusion of Nova SBE Careers and Alumni services.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES. Upon completion of this course, students should be able to:

A. Knowledge and Understanding This course encourages reflective thinking about the self and possible career path.

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B. Subject-Specific Skills This course capacitates students on job search tools and recruitment processes; encourages the use of online tools to support career development and job search.



C. General Skills

This course broadens students' knowledge of specific job areas and functions.

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TEACHING AND LEARNING METHODS.

Short theoretical debrief followed by practical exercises on different subjects related to personal and professional development. When relevant, case studies will be presented.

ASSESSMENT

PASS OR FAIL

Mastering Your Career is a mandatory component of all Masters Programs worth 2 ECTS.

As explained above the requirements for the program are as follows:

- Discovery Week (mandatory to attend the whole Discovery Week event)
- Virtual Career Fair (attendance of at least 1 Talk).
- Career Workshops (mandatory attendance in 1 Career Workshop, enrolled in Bidding)
- Career Events (mandatory attendance in at least 2 Career Events).
- CV Checkpoint (mandatory to score at least 70 points using Vmock).

All sections must be completed during the Fall Semester 2021, by November 26th.

We will not accept permutes between Career Workshops and we will only accept justified absences (each case will be individually evaluated). If a student does not attend the workshop, he/she will automatically be enrolled for a <u>final evaluation format</u>.

Failing the requirements until **November 26th** implies that students will have to go through a final evaluation format.

By failing the Mastering Your Career you will be submitted to a final evaluation format on the next semester.
