

PROBLEM OF USING SOR

What should we do if a company has different products, different departments and the amount of the OH and of the allocation base vary by department?

SOLUTION




Theoretical Class Recap (or not)

Homogenous Cost Pool Method

THE 2 STAGE ALLOCATION PROCESS:

- 1. Assign OH initially to cost centers/cost pools (usually departments);
- 2. Allocating the cost center OH to cost objects (products) using these second stage allocation bases/cost drivers, but HOW?



Theoretical Class Recap (or not)

Homogenous Cost Pool Method

DIRECT ALLOCATION METHOD

Costs of the service cost centers reallocated only to production cost centers

SEQUENTIAL OR STEP-DOWN ALLOCATION METHOD

The service cost center that renders the highest percentage of its total service to other service cost centers is closed first, then the second

SIMULTANEOUS EQUATION METHOD

Allocates costs by explicitly including the mutual services provided among all services cost centers
