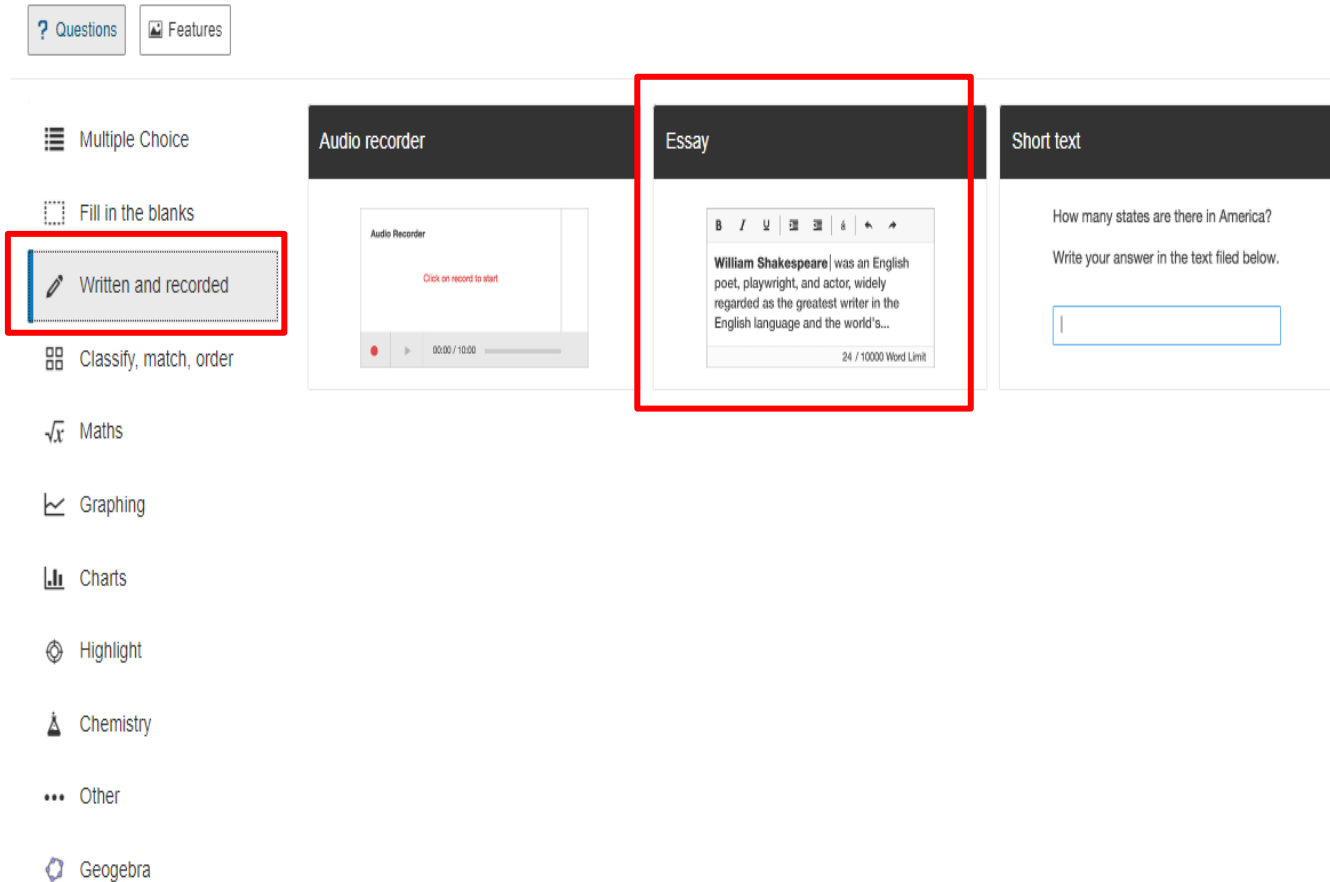

How to set up a test

SELECT QUESTION TYPE – ESSAY



Adding the question – ESSAY QUESTIONS

On the left menu you can find all categories and you can select “Written and recorded”, then click on “Essay”.

CREATE AN ESSAY QUESTION

Defining the question – ESSAY QUESTIONS

A1. Create the question in the editor;

A3. Select if students should be able to see this word limit. Here, you have three options:

- Always visible – students may always see the limit defined;
- On limit: students will only see the word limit after they surpass the maximum number of words defined;
- Off: students will not see the word limit.
