Different meanings in different societies



- ❖ Most known approaches to CSR may be regarded as Anglo-Saxon*, which:
 - 1. <u>Imposes certain assumptions about what CSR means</u> based on theoretically developed measurement scales;
 - 2. Often shares the instrumental perspective on CSR as a business case.
- ❖ Interpretations of the CSR concept <u>reflect the importance of country-specific</u> political, cultural, and social <u>elements</u> (Freeman & Hasnaoui, 2011).
- * Religion also plays a role.

Consumers responses to MNCs non-ethical practices

- * E.g.: Labour rights violations at an MNC's global supply chain
 - Boycott
 - Anger
 - Disgust
 - Contempt
- ❖ Business managers should then take the consumer moral foundations into account when establishing a crisis response strategy:
 - Full apology, and acceptance of responsibility.
- → Accepting responsibility suppresses development of emotional anger.




- * Scandal on IKEA's supply chain in India.





CSR's impact on business




CSR practices:
